Computer Basics Course: *Thursday 10:30-11:30*

This weekly class introduces students who have no prior knowledge of computers to the world of computing. The teacher will instruct the students about the different parts of a computer, how to power up the computer, how to use a mouse, how to start a program, and how to use a web browser.

Intermediate Computer Skills Course: *Tuesday 10:30-11:30*

The teacher covers several revolving subjects, including how to create a simple document, how to use email, how to use an operating system, how to use the internet, how to socially network, and how to search for information.

Microsoft Office Basic Course: *Monday, Wednesday, Friday 12:30-2:30*

This self-paced program offers instruction on the basics of Microsoft Office applications by using a fully interactive simulation for guided hands-on training. Microsoft applications will allow the student to write documents, create presentations, construct spreadsheets, construct databases, make websites, and create cards and other publishable materials.

Computer Repair and Maintenance Course: *Monday, Wednesday, Friday 12:30-2:30*

This self-paced video course offers a detailed introduction to computer hardware, including components, peripherals, repair, basic maintenance, security, networking, and installing/ troubleshooting operating systems and other software.
