VOCATIONAL TRAINING & PLACEMENT

Thirty two new residents of The Kaufmann Apartments at Step Up on Colorado will have access to opportunities for meaningful employment!



Your investment of \$1,500 (per unit) makes pre-vocational training, techniques for job interviews, work adjustment, employment preparation, and job placement possible. Hands-on experiences in paid positions include: word processing; data entry; facilities maintenance; receptionist duties; clerical support; food service; restaurant kitchen operations; and retail associate work. Over 175 members participate in Vocational programs, with 80 individuals employed, and 31 individuals enrolled in an educational program of some type. Participants work as employees of Step Up and Daniel's Place with supported supervision & guidance. There are no failures!
